From 5th to 8th grades, we are working on the conjugation of verbs, descriptive adjectives, nouns, and how to form complete sentences. I assign my students with projects after we have covered grammar, vocabulary, and practiced in group activities in class.

I've introduced to grades 6th to 8th the simple present Tense use of the verb endings AR, IR and ER, and using the verbs "Ser" and "Estar." The students are able to differentiate between these two verbs.

Throughout the school year, I will be imparting classes focusing on the different tenses in Spanish. For grades 7th and 8th, my goal is that by the end of the school year they will be able to comprehend the present tense, future tense, and past tense in Spanish, and be able to apply their knowledge in daily activities.
