Arguments in Public Forum Debates should be persuasive to a person equivalent to a juror in a trial by jury. In making arguments, participants will learn how to display solid logic, sound reasoning, depth of analysis, and use evidence to support their arguments. Participants will also be able learn how to effectively counter argue using the same skills. The ability to communicate in a clear, organized, eloquent and professional manner is critical throughout.

What is the goal of the Public Forum Debate Program? The program strives to provide participating students with a challenging opportunity to develop their critical thinking, and improve their organizational and communication skills.

How is the goal of the Program achieved? A topic is chosen for the Students to devote a time to study, research, and write on that topic.
