### **Professional Development**

- Investment in teachers and staff is vital to classroom success
- Includes Coaching in ELA and Math, Effective use of Use of iReady Data to Drive Instruction, Effective communication, and addressing difficult conversations and situations

- Recent investments focused on safety, security and upgrades




# Safety and Security A Top Priority

- Mandated Active Shooter Training for Staff
- Go Guardian Software Monitors Student Online Activity, Classroom Engagement, and Student Wellness
- Perimeter fencing enhancements completed Summer 2023


