To apply for a seat in Divine Wisdom Catholic Academy in grades K-8, you must provide the following information for consideration by the Admissions Committee:

- Application Form \*
- Financial Obligations Contract \*
- Code of Behavior \*
- Personal Statement \*
- Copy of Birth Certificate or Passport
- Copy of Baptismal Certificate if Roman Catholic
- Copy of Immunization Records
- Copy of most current Report Card and prior year Final Report Card
- Copy of Individualized Education Plan (IEP) and 504 if applicable
- Application Fee – \$200 per child, capped at \$400 per family
- First Month's tuition if applying after April 1

\*These forms are included in this folder.

In addition to providing the above information, you must arrange for your child to spend the day at Divine Wisdom Catholic Academy if they are entering grades 2-8 in September. Your child will be assigned a buddy and will spend the day in a classroom in their current grade. At the end of your child's day there will be a brief meeting with the child, parent or guardian, and a member of the Academy's administration. We believe this step is extremely valuable to ensure that Divine Wisdom Catholic Academy is the right fit for your child academically and socially. If entering grades K-1, you must arrange an interview with our Early Childhood Director.
