Dear Parents,

The children have been continuing to learn about plants. Below are 2 family engagements that your child can choose to complete.



1. You and your child can find and observe a plant together. You can talk about what the plant looks like, how it smells, the way it feels etc. After observing the plant, you can help your child to write or draw about it and they can bring their reflections back to the class for a discussion. We will be assembling these reflections into a class book.
2. During meal time, you can have a discussion with your child on what kinds of plants and plant parts they are eating. You can discuss what kind of plant these foods grow on, as well as where they can be found. For example, cactus pears grow on cactus in the desert or coconuts grow on palm trees in the tropics.

Have fun and we can't wait to hear all about your yummy adventures with the world of plants!
