 - Recycle paper or plastic bottles
- Visit your local library and look for books about Earth Day, recycling, or helping the environment. We realized that plants are a big part of a healthy planet so look for plant books at the library too! Borrowing books from the library is a great way to help the Earth because library books are reused again and again, creating less waste! You do not need to send anything back to school for this activity, just enjoy reading with your child!
