### Math:

All students are expected to stay active on the Mathletics website to keep their math skills sharp over the summer months (all students should have their usernames and passwords on hand). It is the expectation that the following skills be mastered by the entrance into grade 6: **multiplication tables (committed to memory); graphing data; plotting points on a coordinate plane; finding perimeter; finding area of squares, rectangles and triangles; using exponents; applying order of operations (PEMDAS); multiplying and dividing multi-digit numbers; adding/subtracting decimals; changing mixed numbers into improper fractions (and reverse).**

If students are having difficulty with a particular topic or skill mentioned above, it is suggested that students practice on the Mathletics website, so that these skills can be mastered by September. Otherwise, the sixth grade curriculum might cause increased difficulty.
