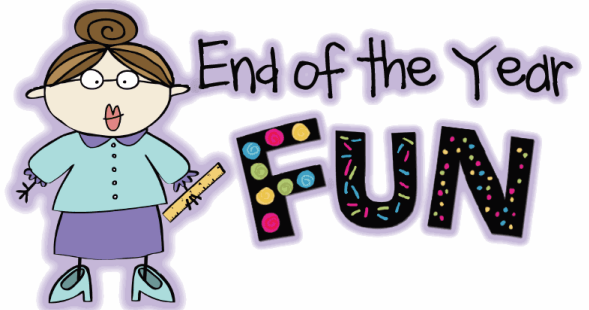


End of Year 6th Grade News

weeks, they will still be required to complete two reading responses in their journals as part of their homework.
