Each week, you are responsible for 2 reading responses. Notebooks will be collected immediately, beginning the day on Fridays. Be sure to include a heading on your responses with includes the date and the title of the book. You may only choose the same question ONCE per week!

1. If you could pick a character in your book to have as a friend, who would it be and why?
2. Describe the setting with lots of details.
3. If you could change the setting of the story, where would you change it to and why?
4. Who tells the story? Is this the best person to tell it? Why?
5. Explain a character's problem and then offer your character advice on how to solve his/her problem.
6. What real-life events are you reminded of by characters or events in the story?
7. Discuss a part of your reading that was your favorite. What made this part stand out to you?
8. What makes you wonder while reading this book? What confuses you?
9. Did this book make you smile? Laugh? Cry? Cringe? Cheer? Explain.
10. Write a detailed letter to the author of the book critiquing the story.
11. Choose a conflict in the book that a character had. What advice would you give your character and why?
12. Choose a sentence from the book; illustrate how you saw it happen while reading. Describe what is occurring in the picture.
13. If you could step into the book, what would be the first thing you did?
