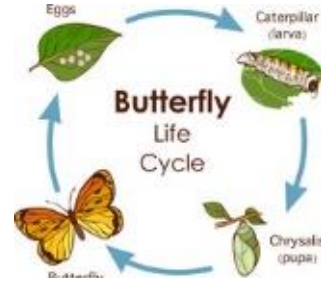
Special Announcements:

This week we discussed many things in nature that change or transform, including the weather and seasons, the *metamorphosis* of some insects, and animals that transform to camouflage themselves. We read *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* by Eric Carle and compared this to non-fiction books about caterpillars and butterflies.

At the Art Center we created butterfly blots and looked at the symmetry of their wings.

At the Science Center we reviewed the transformation that occurs when ice melts into water. We used our science skills to uncover special treasure in blocks of ice!

We talked more about how the children have ‘transformed’ this year.
