Beginning the Week of September 20th Academy students in grades 1-8 will take the first of three ELA diagnostic assessments. Kindergarten students will take the assessment at a later date as they are still getting the hang of being kindergartners! Attached is a letter regarding the launch of i-Ready in the 2021-2022 school year. i-Ready identifies which students are experiencing difficulties with specific skills, providing real-time, actionable data and reports to guide teachers in effective intervention. i-Ready uses a scale to measure student performance indicating the skills they have already mastered and the skills they need to work on throughout the year. Parent reports will be sent home in October.

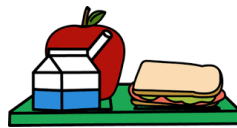
Do Good with Chipotle
