Special Announcements:

We will be celebrating Halloween on Friday October 29th. Students in 3K can wear a Halloween costume to school, as long as all peripheral items (such as swords, guns, wands, etc...) are kept at home. They should wear sneakers. Also no face painting. Children should be able to use the bathroom as independently as possible in their costumes.

Reminders:

- Please continue to dress your child for outdoor play, including appropriate outerwear and sneakers. 3K will be playing outside even as the weather gets colder. You can support your child's self-help skills by encouraging them to dress themselves for outdoor play!
- Please dress your child in sneakers for running around the playground and on Monday's for gym class.

- Please have your child practice putting on their jackets and fixing their sleeves when taking their jacket off

This week in 3K we started our new unit on Self by exploring what makes us unique and important! We read Be Who You Are by Todd Parr and learned that we are all unique and special regardless on how we look, act, feel, or like to do!

At the Math Center we explored our colors by sorting them into color groups. As a challenge, the children were encouraged to count the number of objects in each color group.

At the Art Center children learned how to use watercolor paint and create beautiful masterpieces!

At the Science Center the children continued to explore the season of Fall by using a magnifying glass to observe leaves and pinecones. They were encouraged to describe what they saw and how these objects felt.
