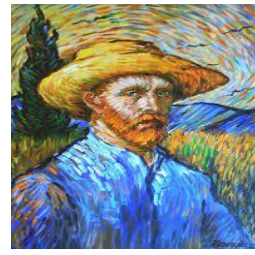
Special Announcements:

This week we started our unit on **Investigating**, by looking at and discussing famous artists and paintings.

In the Art Center the children had an opportunity to observe a famous painting and try to recreate it by identifying the colors that they see and describing what the picture was of.

The children also had an opportunity to explore various ways of painting, such as with a Q-tip or a clothespin with a pompom. The children got to discuss their experience while using this by explaining things such as, was it easier or harder to paint with than a paintbrush? What was their favorite tool to paint with?

Next week we will continue to explore our unit on Investigating by focusing on arctic animals.
