This week we focused on Arctic Animals. We read the book **Polar Region** and discussed why we think arctic animals live in the polar region area. We also discussed how these animals are able to live and survive in such a cold place on the Earth.

At the Art Center, children drew pictures of arctic animals on a Polar Region mural. They got to decide what animal they would like to draw and investigate the characteristics of this animal, such as feathers, tusks, fur, and so on.

The children also reviewed their shapes by creating shape penguins. The children got to choose and identify the different shapes that they would like their penguin to be.

Next week we will explore different kinds of concepts by experimenting and testing out our ideas of what we think will happen to various things.
