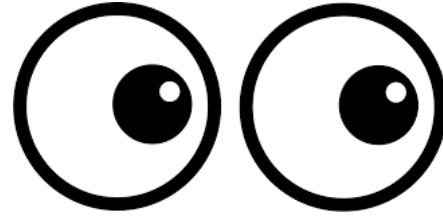




3K Newsletter Week of January 3rd - 7th

This week we finished our unit on Seeing by using our eyes to see all the changes around us. We spoke about how it gets darker earlier and that we don't see any insects or bugs due to the new season of Winter.

At the Art Center the children started to be exposed to the safety of child safe scissors and how to properly use them when cutting.

We have started to read books about Winter and briefly discussed arctic animals. After reading a book about polar animals, the children learned that polar animals have different things that help them survive in the environment that they are born in, such as thick fur so that arctic wolves can keep warm, flippers to help seals swim very fast, and even tusks to help walrus' pull themselves out of the water because they have no hands!

Next week we will start our new unit on Investigating by looking closely at things around us.
