This week we ended our unit on Buildings by focusing on what construction is and why it's important. We spoke about different kinds of construction vehicles, as well as types of tools that construction workers may use to do their job.

We read a variety of books that spoke about construction and construction vehicles. The children had an opportunity to express what their favorite vehicle was and why.

In the Art Center, the children had an opportunity to create different types of construction vehicles using 3D materials from recycled items, such as paper towel roll cans and drink containers.

The children enjoyed pretending to use their vehicles in the Block Center to create different types of buildings.

Next week we will be starting our unit on Moving by focusing on things that move around us.
