Thank you to everybody who met with me about your child's progress. It is always a pleasure touching base with all of you on how your child is progressing throughout the year!

This week we continued our unit on Moving by focusing on how vehicles move. We spoke about different kinds of vehicles, such as vehicles that move on land, sea, and air. We also spoke about parts of vehicles.

We read a variety of books about vehicles. The children got into a discussion about what type of vehicles are slow and fast, as well as why they think that.

In the Art Center, the children had an opportunity to create a type vehicle of their choosing by using various items to make that vehicle. Some of the vehicles that were made were from recycled materials, collage materials, or simply a drawing of a vehicle.

The children had an opportunity to act out different types of vehicles during a movement session during our day.

Next week we will be continuing our unit on Moving by investigating how we move through the city.
