Dear 3K Families,

Next week we will be starting our unit on Change by focusing on how things change. You can support this by having your child put water in a cup and squeeze a few drops of food dye to change the color of the water to whatever color your child would like. Then, have your child put a flower, preferably white, in the cup of colored water. If you don't have a flower, then you can use something else, such as celery, lettuce, and so on. Wait a few hours. Have your child observe what is happening. You can ask your child questions, such as what do you think will happen? What is happening to the flower (or whatever your child chose to use)? Why do you think this is happening? Does it look the same way or different as when you started the experiment? Tell me about it. You can write down your child's dictations on what they say. They may provide pictures of themselves doing their experiment. Have fun!
