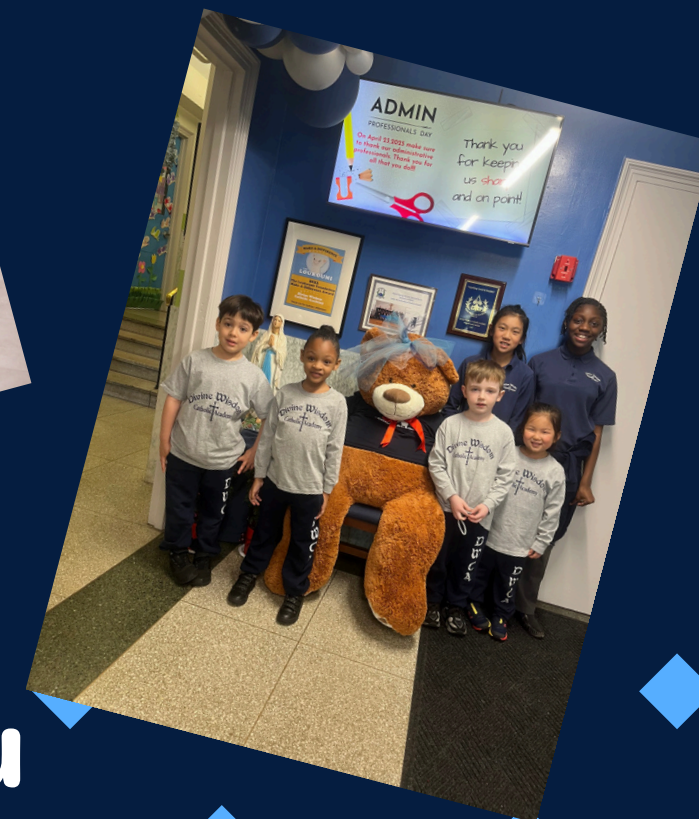

# Streamlining Operations Through Technology



## Supporting Safety, Communication, and Schoolwide Growth

**We are thoughtfully expanding our use of technology to better support our students, families, and staff. These tools help us streamline daily operations, strengthen communication, enhance safety, and position Divine Wisdom for continued growth—while keeping our focus where it belongs: on our students and their learning experience.**

## **Introducing ORAH**

**We're excited to introduce ORAH (Online Registered Access Hub), a new digital system launching in early spring in phases that enhances building safety, attendance tracking, and daily school operations. ORAH helps us know who is in the building, where classes are throughout the day, and keeps families informed—all while streamlining daily routines.**



# How ORAH Supports Our Divine Wisdom Community:

## Visitor Management & Screening:

- All visitors, volunteers, and guests sign in at a secure kiosk
- First-time visitors present a valid photo ID for verification and background check
- A printed visitor badge is issued and must be worn while on campus
- The school can see exactly who is in the building at all times

## Efficient Sign-In for Repeat Visitors:

- Approved repeat visitors may sign in by entering their name
- No need to rescan ID at every visit
- A visitor badge is printed for each visit



## **Attendance for All Classes:**

- **Attendance is taken for every class period, including Enrichment classes**
- **Supports Grades 4–8 departmentalized schedules as students move throughout the building**
- **Ensures accurate records of student location during the school day**

## **Absences & Lateness:**

- **Absences and lateness are submitted through ORAH**
- **Families receive an email confirmation once the information is recorded**
- **Attendance alerts may be sent to help keep families informed**



## **Emergency Preparedness & Safety**

- **Real-time attendance supports Fire Drills and Emergency Evacuations**
- **Staff can quickly confirm student locations and accountability using their cellphone**
- **Improves coordination and response in emergency situations**
- **Integrated & Streamlined Systems**
- **Works in coordination with FACTS for consistent school records**
- **Centralizes attendance, visitor management, and daily workflows**
- **Families will receive notifications related to frequent absences or lateness**
- **Supports open communication between school and families**
- **Reduces paperwork**

# **Growing with FACTS PAYMENT FORMS**

**We began using FACTS as a tuition payment plan and admissions and re registration process. As our school has grown, the need for more streamlined and efficient systems has become increasingly important.**

**At the beginning of this school year, we introduced FACTS Payment Forms as part of our expanded use of FACTS. This allows us to streamline forms, automate payments, and manage both financial and non-financial workflows more effectively across the school.**

**By reducing administrative time and manual processes, we are able to redirect time and resources back where they belong—into our students, teachers, and classrooms.**



## **Financial Efficiency & Controls:**

- **Automated collection of non-tuition revenue**
- **Payments are automatically applied to the correct ledger account**
- **Consolidated deposits aligned with existing financial processes**
- **Reduced manual posting, reconciliation, and error correction**

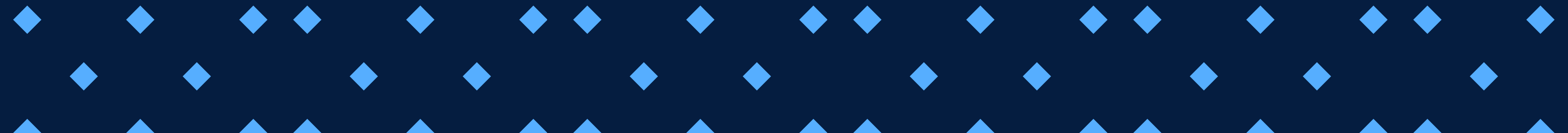

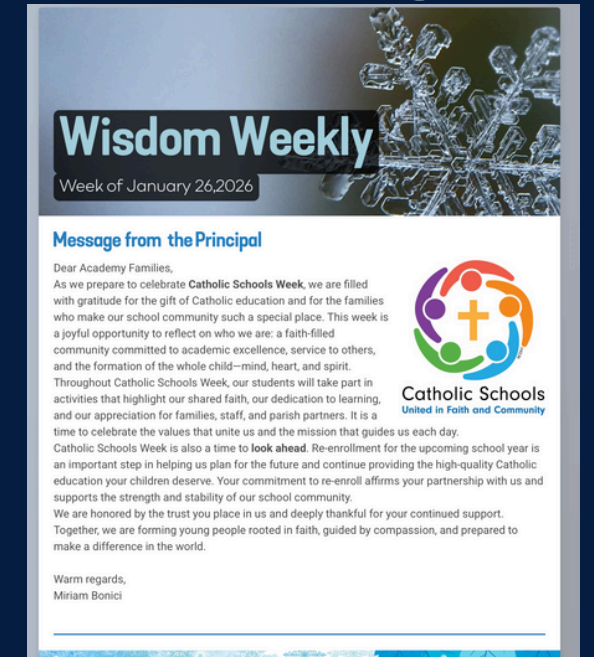
# Strengthening Family Communication

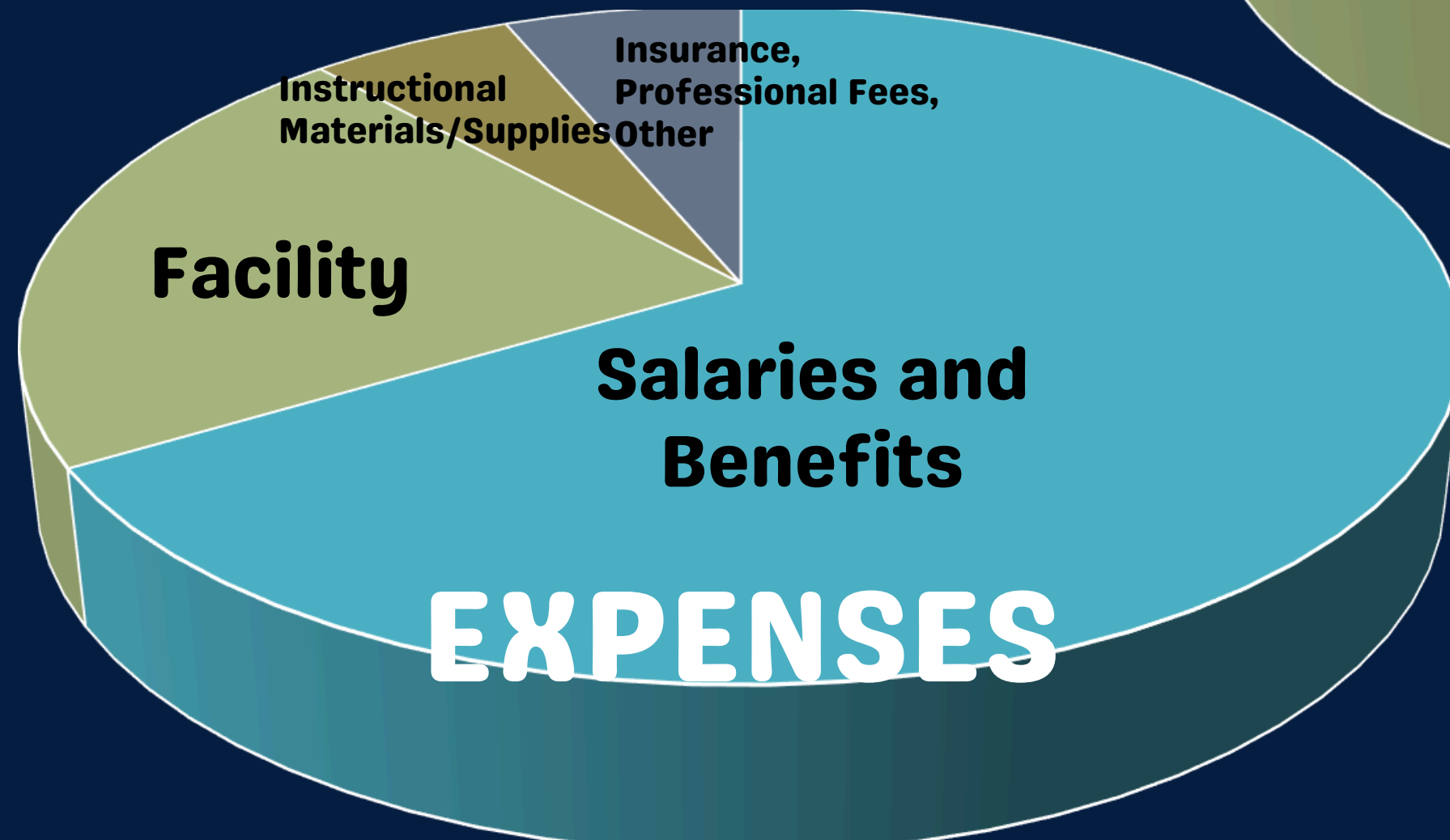
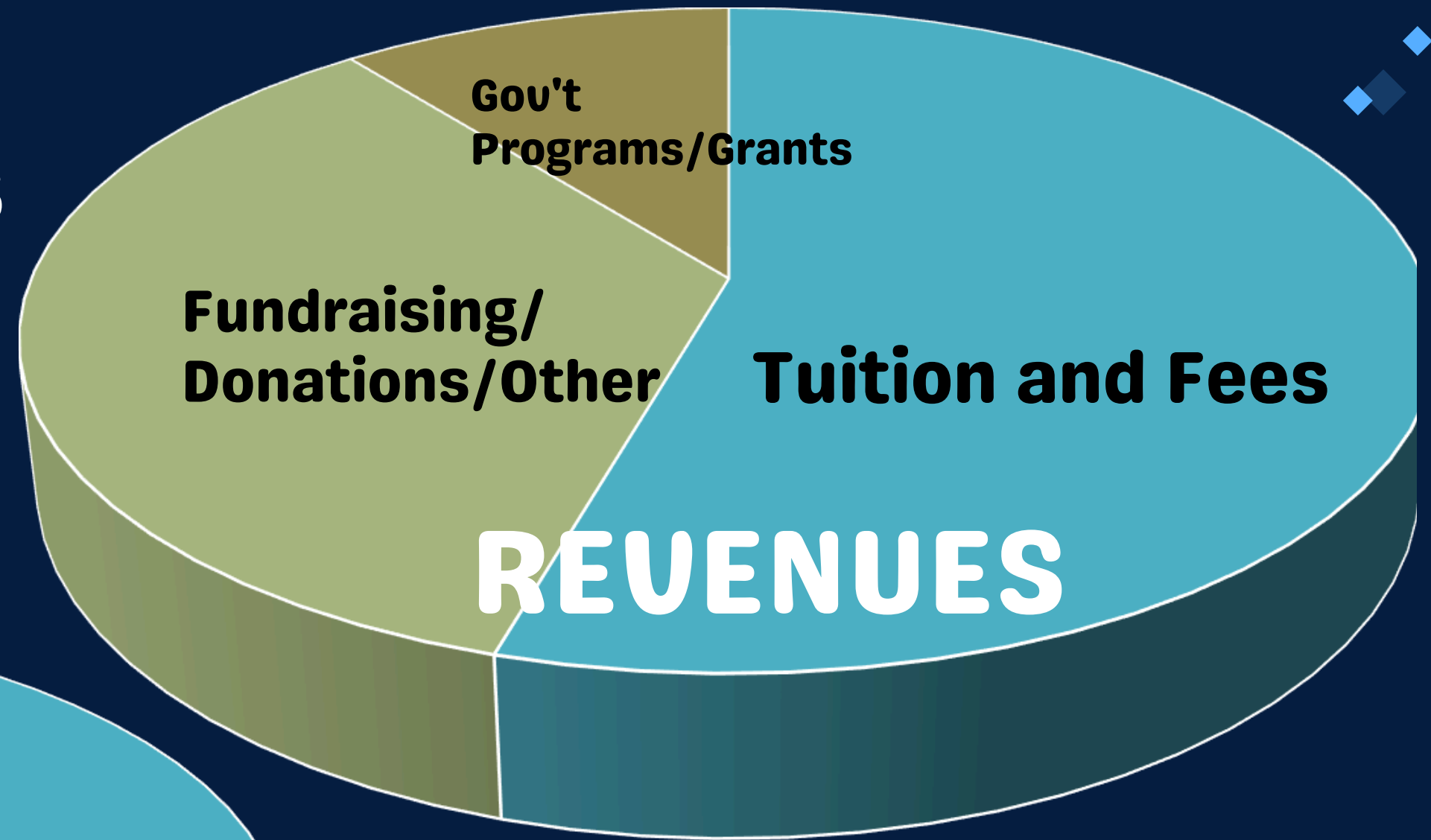

# **Will Governor Hochul Opt-in to Support Kids & Schools?**

**Starting in 2027, the new Federal Scholarship Tax Credit will let taxpayers redirect up to \$1,700 of their federal income taxes to nonprofit scholarship organizations that provide tuition assistance for students in Catholic schools.**

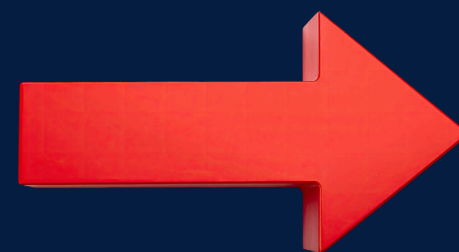
