

Tuition Rates, Fees, Service Hours



- Tuition Only Covers 60% of Operating Costs (no Pandemic costs Charged)
- Remaining 40%, as well as Infrastructure Investments Covered by Fundraising, Donations, Mandated Services Reimbursements, and Grants (incl. Seton Fund)

Tuition Rates for 2023-2024 Academic Year

Kindergarten through 8th Grade

Catholic Affiliated Rate:

One Child \$6,320 - \$632 per month
Two Children \$9,700 - \$970 per month
Three Children \$12,650 - \$1,265 per month
Four or more Children \$15,200 - \$1,520 per month

Non-Catholic Rate:

One Child \$7,015 - \$701.50 per month
Two Children \$10,915 - \$1,091.50 per month
Three or more Children \$14,250 - \$1,425 per month
Four or more Children \$17,085 - \$1,708.50 per month

NON-REFUNDABLE costs (due at time of Registration):

Registration Fees:

Students currently in grades K-8:

- \$125 per student capped at \$250 per family if registered by February 3, 2023.
- \$200 per student capped at \$400 per family.

Families with no current students in grades K-8:

- \$200 per student capped at \$400 per family.

Academic, Art, and Class Activity Fee - \$150 per student in grades K-8.

Kindergarten Security Deposit (applied to first month's Kindergarten tuition)

Families with students currently in grades K-8 - NOT APPLICABLE.

Families with no students currently in grades K-8 - \$300.

Fundraising requirements for families with students in grades K-8:

Turkey Trot - Minimum fund-raise of \$50 per student in grades K-8.

Service Hours - 15 hours per family towards approved activities. Families not fulfilling the minimum 15 service hour requirement will be charged \$50 per hour not served.



- Applied for FEMA Reimbursement of \$300K COVID Costs
- Awarded Security Grants Totaling \$200K for Security Infrastructure Enhancements
- Obtained Contracts for Fully Funded PreK 3 and PreK 4 programs at \$1 Million Per Year so Families Receive Quality Education at No Cost
- Established Hardship Fund to Assist Families
 Experiencing Unexpected Financial Hardships
- Awarded Grant for Costs of Full Day Security Guard
- Maintained Full Time Registered Nurse & Part Time Counselor through Government Programs at No Cost to Families
